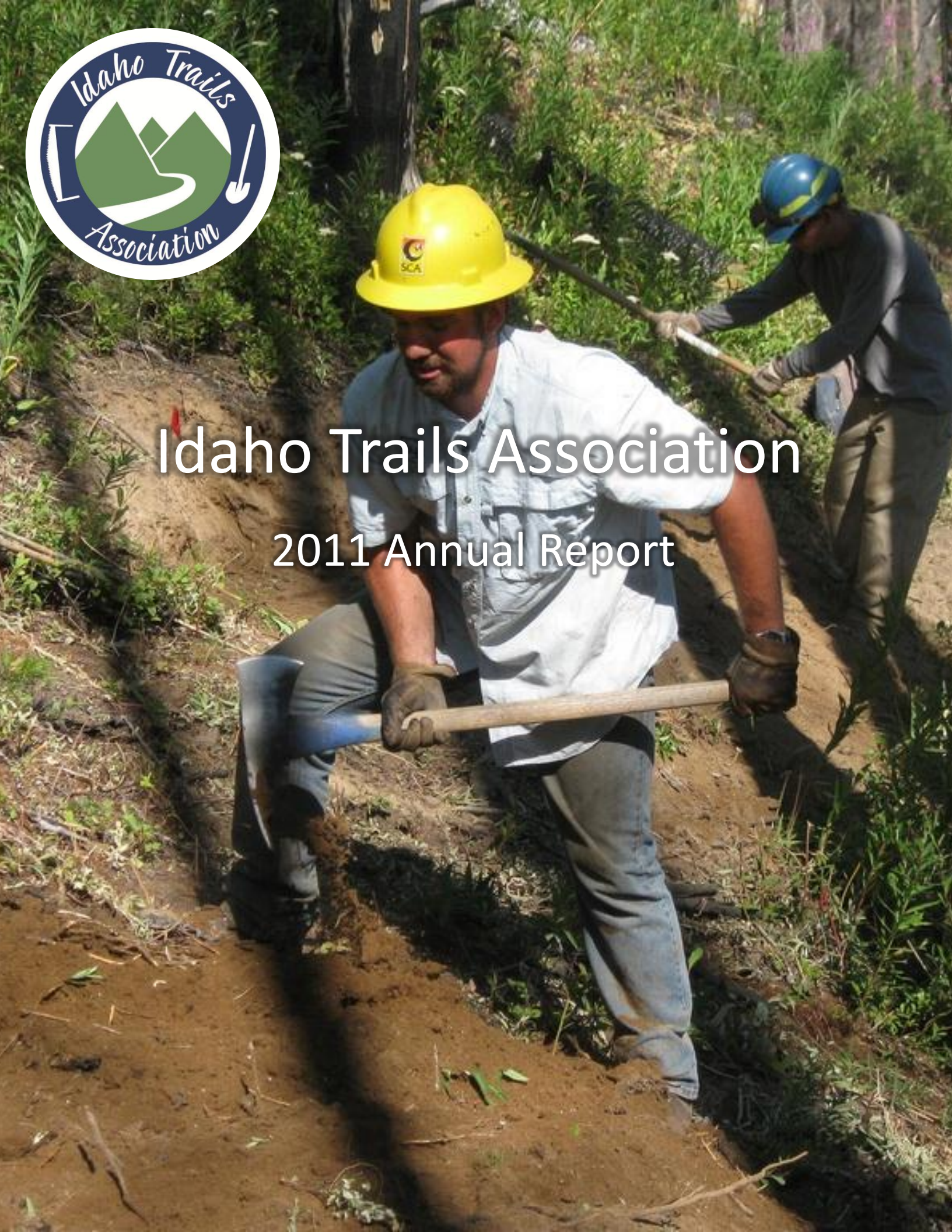

## Outcomes

- Fifty-eight volunteers contributed a combined 1,036 hours of service.
- More than 22 miles of trails were maintained or improved on National Forest and Bureau of Land Management lands.
- Approximately two miles of new trails were constructed.
- One-hundred and eighty-eight down trees and logs were cleared from trails.
- One-hundred and eighty-nine trail drains were cleaned, repaired, or installed.
- Three new trail bridges were constructed.
- One new trailhead kiosk was constructed.

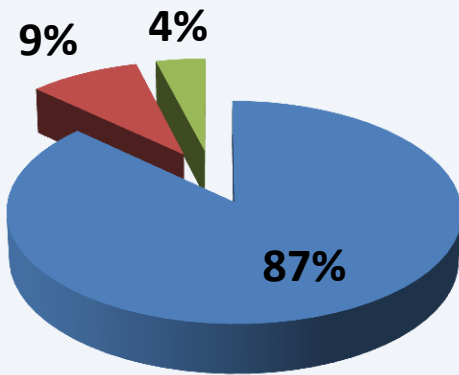

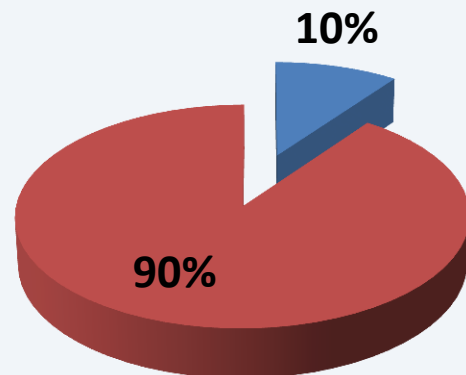
